Re-entry Prep Should Start on Day One For Teen Offenders, Says Longtime Inmate

Steve Austin was convicted for murder and sent to prison at 16. He would have died there, if not for a crucial Supreme Court ruling.

In 1975, Austin was sentenced to life without the possibility for parole by a judge in Philadelphia after he was convicted for killing a man during an argument. More than 40 years later, a 2016 U.S. Supreme Court decision determined that a ban on life sentences for juvenile offenders must be applied retroactively. It enabled Austin to be resentenced and finally leave prison.

Since his release, Austin has worked on "participatory defense," an initiative that helps defendants and incarcerated people better advocate for themselves. His experience as a teen growing up, amid, what he called "the turmoil" of jails and prisons has given him

Hollis native and hip hop legend LL Cool J is taking a concert promoter to civil court for repurposing one of his many hit songs for more than a decade to advertise and monetize its events.

In 1985, LL Cool J, whose real name is James Todd Smith, landed on the music scene with his gold and platinum selling debut album "Radio." The third single from that record was "Rock the Bells," co-written Rick Rubin.

Smith's fame did not end 33 years ago, nor did the popularity of "Rock the Bells." Yet, in 2004, Chang Weisberg, the president and founder of Guerilla Union, Inc., held the first

Bite Out of Crime: Suspected Penis-Bitten Rapist Faces Charges

A 21-year-old man turned himself into police on Wednesday afternoon for sexually assaulting a woman — who bit his penis to escape — inside his South Richmond Hill apartment, prosecutors said.

Nickolos Samaroo is facing substantial prison time after he allegedly punched a woman unconscious and forced her to perform oral sex at knifepoint.

The 39-year-old woman bit Samaroo's genitals to fend him off and escape, police said.

The brutal attack happened on Nov. 9 around 3 a.m. inside an apartment on 101st Avenue where Samaroo lives, the police confirmed.

When the woman regained consciousness, Samaroo, 21, tried to remove her pants, police said. The woman distracted Samaroo and attempted to run into the bathroom to get away from him, but he grabbed and dragged her into the bedroom, police said.

Samaroo, 21, allegedly knocked the woman out again. When she woke up, Samaroo allegedly stuck a knife to her face. The alleged rapist threatened to kill her if she did not comply with his demands and forced her to perform oral sex, police said.


The woman chomped down on Samaroo's genitals as hard as she could, according to the criminal complaint. When Samaroo fell to the ground, she fled to safety, police said. It is unclear whether the victim and Samaroo knew each other prior to the attack, police said.

Samaroo was seen on surveillance video fleeing his home barefoot and shirtless.

The woman was treated at a nearby hospital for a cut to her face and right leg.

Samaroo was arraigned in Queens Criminal Court on Thursday for first-degree criminal sex act, second-degree assault and fourth-degree criminal possession of a weapon charges.

If convicted, he faces up to 25 years in prison for the top charge.

ALLEGED CHOP SHOP BANDIT ARRAIGNED IN SUPREME COURT

Chukuweike Emeni of Far Rockaway is charged with third-degree insurance fraud for allegedly stealing large vans, stripping them and selling the parts. Emenei appears in TAP A for Supreme Court arraignment.

Emeni and two co-defendants were charged

with carrying out an elaborate scheme to steal Econoline vans and selling the tires, seats, bumpers, radios, rooftops and various other car parts. The three people allegedly targeted vehicles in East Elmhurst, Flushing, Jackson Heights, Kew Gardens, Little Neck and parts of Nassau County between July 2017 and February 2018.

"The defendants in this case turned an illegal venture into a dedicated job," Queens District Attorney Richard Brown said in a statement. "They lurked in the middle of the night or early hours of the morning allegedly stealing vans, arranging meets to sell parts and even quoted prices - \$100 for seats, \$120 for radios. A long-term, detailed investigation uncovered this scheme that has now been shut down. The defendants face serious prison time for their goal of enriching themselves at the expense of others."

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TRIAL CONTINUES FOR AC INSTALLER

Yuriy Kurk, the owner of a Jamaica Estates HVAC company, is charged with attempted assault for allegedly for allegedly attempting to poison a family with toxic mercury. He appears in court today for the continuation of his trial.

Kruk, a Rego Park resident and the owner of A+HVAC and Kitchen Corporation, laced the family's AC unit with mercury in retaliation for the family's frequent complaints, Queens County District Attorney Richard Brown said in May.

Each family member later tested positive for mercury poisoning.

"The defendant allegedly had a final fix for

the complainers and is alleged to have placed poisonous mercury in the new AC. Exposure to the element could prove fatal over time and did make the residents sick. Fortunately a family member spotted the chemical commonly referred to as quicksilver and alerted police," Brown said in a statement in May.

City Says Lyft Plans To Invest \$100M In Citi Bike Expansion

No 'Reveal' Yet on Locations In Brooklyn & Queens

New York City has reached an agreement with Lyft, the new owner of Citi Bike's parent company, to "dramatically expand" the Citi Bike bike-share program.

Under the agreement, Lyft will invest \$100 million to improve the system and double its service area, the Mayor's Office announced yesterday.

Still, don't expect an immediate expansion to far-flung areas of the city like Coney Island and Flatlands in Brooklyn or Ozone Park and Bayside in Queens.

A spokesman for Transportation Alternatives, the well-known bicycle and pedestrian advocacy organization, told the *Brooklyn Eagle* that in response to a question at yesterday's press conference, city Transportation Commission Polly Trottenberg said that while exact details haven't worked out, Citi Bike will expand "contiguously," next to neighborhoods that already have Citi Bike stations.

Currently, Citi Bike in Queens is concentrated in Long Island City and Astoria, with some stations immediately east of those areas. In Brooklyn, Citi Bike stations are found in Greenpoint, Williamsburg, Bushwick, Bed-Stuy west of Malcolm X Boulevard, Clinton Hill, Prospect Heights, Crown Heights west of Bedford Avenue, Fort Greene, DUMBO, the Navy Yard area, Brooklyn Heights, Cobble Hill, Carroll Gardens, Gowanus, Boerum Hill, the Columbia Street District, Red Hook and Park Slope north of 14th Street.

Mayor Bill de Blasio, at the press conference, revealed several other details of the expansion:

Citi Bike will triple in size

to nearly 40,000 bicycles and expand by 35 square miles over five years.

Within 90 days, Lyft will invest to restore the existing system to its required fleet level of 12,000 bikes.

The expanded fleet will include both regular and pedal-assist bikes, which are part of the DOT's L-train tunnel shutdown mitigation plan.

Lyft will add 12 new valet stations and increase availability in the busiest areas.

The Reduced Fare Bike Share program, which provides discount membership of \$5 per month for all NYCHA residents and SNAP recipient, will be expanded.

In general, Brooklyn and Queens elected officials had good words for the Citi Bike expansion.

"I'm truly excited to see Lyft's incredible investment in expanding our growing Citi Bike programs," said Brooklyn Borough President Eric Adams. "In addition to the extended commitment to funding low-cost membership for NYCHA residents and SNAP recipients, I hope this results in an extension of our borough's bike share network through docking stations in new neighborhoods."

"As an avid biker, I know firsthand the convenience and ease that Citi Bike affords," said Councilmember Carlos Menchaca (D-Red Hook-Sunset Park). "With this infusion of funding, Lyft will help expand a critical service in light of our city's ongoing transportation needs. Moving forward, though, we must ensure bikes are distributed equitably."

State Sen. Michael Gianaris (D-Long Island City-Astoria-Sunnyside-Woodside) said, "Citi Bike is a valuable resource, and I was proud to play a role in securing its expansion into Astoria and Long Island City."

Corona Man Arrested for Rape Near Prospect Park

A Queens man was arrested on Wednesday for sexually assaulting and choking a woman near Prospect Park, police said.

Mowngly Lucas — who was released on his own recognizance by Brooklyn Criminal Court Judge Claudia Daniels-DePeyster for a June robbery case — allegedly attacked a 59-year-old woman from behind and put her in a chokehold near Parade Place and Parkside Avenue.

During the Nov. 18 attack around 4 a.m., Lucas told the woman that he was armed with a knife and gun and would hurt her if she didn't comply with his demands, police said.

Lucas, 28, allegedly pushed the woman onto a parked van and attempted to rape her but was unable. Instead, he dragged her behind to a park bench and raped her, police said.

Afterwards, Lucas broke into a van, dragged the woman inside and tried to rape her again, but failed, police said. He allegedly stole \$10 from her purse, kicked her out of the vehicle and walked away from the crime scene.

Lucas was seen walking out of the park and at the Franklin Avenue train station.

Police charged Lucas with two counts of rape, robbery, strangulation, burglary, sexual abuse and unlawful imprisonment.

Lucas is currently awaiting to be arraigned in Brooklyn Criminal Court.

This isn't the first case where Lucas is accused of choking a stranger.

In June, Lucas put a man in a chokehold near the corner of Ocean Avenue and Glenwood Road and stole \$74, according to the criminal complaint. He was arrested days later and charged with second-degree robbery and a slew of other charges including criminal obstruction of breathing or blood circulation.

Lucas' case was still pending grand jury action in Brooklyn Supreme Court, according to court records. If convicted of the June robbery case, Lucas faces up to 15 years in prison.

Test Prep Is a Rite Of Passage for Many Asian-Americans

When ACT released its latest test scores this past October, the results showed that average scores took a dip for every racial group in the United States except one — Asian-Americans.

A similar situation played out with the SAT. Asian-Americans experienced a gain over the prior year — 42 points on a 1,600-point scale — whereas other groups had more modest gains, no gains, or lost ground.

The issue of Asian-Americans' high test scores featured prominently in a pending legal case in which a group called Students for Fair Admissions — led by an activist who opposes the consideration of race in college admissions — alleges that Asian-Americans are discriminated against in Harvard College's admission process.

As a researcher who specializes in the study of Asian-Americans and higher education, I see three factors that help explain this trend around test scores.

1. Many Asian-American Students Are Socialized into Test Prep

As I document in my book, "Race on Campus," many Asian-American students get frequent messages from an early age about the importance of doing well on tests. Test prep businesses may post an "honor roll" that features local youth and their elite college destinations. Relatives may stress that good test scores matter.

These messages are powerful, as explained in the book "The Asian American Achievement Paradox." They set up high expectations for Asian-American students. Test prep becomes a way of meeting those expectations.

In many ways, these messages reflect the influence of East Asia, where college admission is decided on a single high-stakes test — such as China's *gaokao* or South Korea's *suneung* — and where intense test prep is a regular feature of teenage life. For that reason, many Asian immigrant parents see the SAT or ACT as the equivalent of Asia's admissions tests. As a result, many conclude that test prep is a worthy investment.

This helps explain why Asian-Americans — in particular Chinese- and Korean-Americans — have the highest rate of participation in SAT/ACT test prep.

In one study, I found that over half of Korean-Americans and 42 percent of Chinese-Americans took an SAT prep course prior to college, compared to 35.6 percent of white students, 32.4 percent of Hispanic students and 40.4 percent of black students. While affluent Asian-Americans are more likely to take test prep, 46.7 percent of low-income Korean-Americans still took a prep course.

2. Asian-Americans Are Better Prepared to Benefit

East Asian-Americans are the only group that show statistically significant gains from test prep. Average gains linked with test prep are more in the range of 10-30 points, versus the hundreds of points that are often advertised. Why?

Test prep tends to work best when students already have high levels of academic preparation. While there is a wide range of experiences within the Asian-American community, on average, Asian-Americans tend to have access to higher quality K-12 education than other minority groups.

They are also less likely to attend racially segregated, poorly resourced schools, unlike their black and Hispanic counterparts.

For these reasons, even some lower-income Asian-Americans enter test prep with high levels of prior educational achievement.

This is not to say that test prep can't help students with weak academic preparation. It just won't help in a way that will radically transform their ACT or SAT score, most likely. For instance, one study found no significant benefit from test prep among a sample of low-income students.

3. Test Prep Companies Target Asian-American Communities

Test prep businesses that cater to Asian-Americans are a mainstay in urban centers like Koreatown in Los Angeles or heavily Asian suburbs, such as the San Gabriel Valley, as noted sociology professor Min Zhou has found.

Signs in the front window of these businesses advertise in multiple languages. These test prep companies also advertise in Asian-language newspapers and ethnic media. Their presence is hard to miss, making SAT/ACT prep highly visible and available for Asian-American students. As *The New York Times* observed, most of New York City's 411 prep centers are based in Queens and Brooklyn, "with over

a quarter of them springing up in the past four years alone, most notably in the boroughs' Asian enclaves of Flushing and Sunset Park in Brooklyn."

"On the opposite coast, 861 such tutoring centers exist in California's Orange, Santa Clara and Los Angeles counties, all heavy with Asian-American families," the article states.

Beyond Test Scores

Related to the Harvard case, test scores for all students should be considered with a grain of salt. Yes, high scores are impressive, but they should be understood in the context of opportunity. It's also

important to note that strong scores are the norm in Harvard's applicant pool.

Given that test scores are limited in their ability to predict future achievement, and are heavily shaped by race and social class, colleges should consider the value of SAT-optional or even doing away with the test.

But as long as the ACT and SAT remain part of college admissions, it should be understood that test prep alone won't be enough to eliminate racial disparities in standardized test scores.

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Michael Cohen Pleads Guilty to Lying to Congress

Michael Cohen, President Donald Trump's former lawyer, made a surprise appearance before a federal judge in Manhattan yesterday and pleaded guilty to lying to Congress to cover up that he was negotiating a real estate deal in Moscow on Trump's behalf during the heat of his campaign for the Republican presidential nomination.

Trump called Cohen a "weak person" who is lying to get a lighter sentence.

The charge was brought by Special Counsel Robert Mueller, who is investigating Russian interference in the presidential election, and was the result of his cooperation with that probe.

Flanked by his lawyers, Cohen admitted making false statements about the project in 2017 to Senate and House intelligence committees, which at the time were investigating possible connections between the Trump campaign and Russia.

His comments made clear that his communications with Trump about the project were much more frequent than he had suggested.

Cohen, 52, wearing a blue tie and dark suit, was noticeably relaxed throughout the appearance in a packed Manhattan courtroom, unlike his irritable and emotional demeanor when he entered a guilty plea during the summer.

Cohen told the judge he lied

about the timing of the negotiations, his communications with people in the company and in Russia about the deal, and other details to be loyal to Trump and consistent with Trump's "political messaging." Cohen and prosecutors referred to Trump as "individual one" throughout yesterday's proceedings and said he lied "to be loyal to Individual One."

Among other lies, Cohen said he told Congress that all discussions about building a Trump Tower in Moscow had ended by January 2016, when they had actually continued until June of that year.

He said he also lied about his contacts with Russian officials and lied when he said he never agreed to travel to Russia in connection with the project and never discussed with Trump plans to travel to Moscow to support the project.

Prosecutors said in a court document that Cohen had misled Congress to give a false impression that the Moscow project had ended before the Iowa caucus and first Republican presidential primary in 2016.

As he left the White House shortly after the court proceeding concluded, Trump called Cohen "a weak person."

"Michael Cohen is lying and he's trying to get a reduced sentence," Trump said.

Nothing said in court, or in associated court filings, addressed whether Trump or his aides had directed Cohen to mislead Congress.

The charges were handled by Mueller's team, not the federal prosecutors in New York who handled Cohen's previous guilty plea in August to other federal charges involving his taxi businesses, bank fraud and his campaign work for Trump. Cohen is scheduled to be sentenced Dec. 12.

Cohen declined to comment as he left the courtroom.

Cohen's lawyer, Guy Petrillo, noted that a letter from federal prosecutors showed that Cohen's cooperation with Mueller will be described to Cohen's sentencing judge. However, the letter makes clear that Cohen is not receiving the kind of "5K1.1" letter written

on behalf of formal government cooperators.

Reacting to the plea, House Speaker Paul Ryan said Cohen "should be prosecuted to the extent of the law. That's why we put people under oath."

Cohen gave a statement to congressional committees last year saying the president's company pursued a project in Moscow during the Republican primary but that the plan was abandoned "for a variety of business reasons."

Cohen also said he sent an email to the spokesman for Russian President Vladimir Putin as part of the potential deal.

In his statement, he said that

he worked on the real estate proposal with Felix Sater, a Russia-born associate who he said claimed to have deep connections in Moscow.

The discussions about the potential development began after Trump had declared his candidacy. Cohen had said the talks ended when he determined that the project was not feasible.

Cohen had also disclosed that Trump was personally aware of the deal, signing a letter of intent and discussing it with Cohen on two other occasions.

A massive Norway spruce has been lit up in a tradition that ushers in Christmastime in New York City. Re-entry Prep Should Start on Day One For Teen Offenders, Says Longtime Inmate

perspective on how to better serve incarcerated young people — the vast majority of whom will eventually be released back into society.

“At age 16, I can’t tell you what a shock it is,” Austin said. “You have to grow up in a hurry. You have to be smart and aware and learn how to navigate. And you resign yourself to the idea that ‘I’m going to survive, whatever it takes.’”

Austin is one of 90 members of the Incarcerated Children Action Network (ICAN), an alliance of people sentenced to prison as adolescents across 25 states, including New York.

“These individuals are experts who demonstrate through their advocacy that children, even those convicted of serious crimes, can mature and become rehabilitated,” ICAN says in its mission statement. “ICAN identifies, mobilizes, and amplifies the experiences of individuals incarcerated as youth to

inform the public debate about children’s capacity for positive change and to debunk racially charged and dehumanizing narratives that seek to justify extreme sentencing of youth.

Austin said that high-stress environment affects development and can influence behavior, emotions and coping strategies for life, an issue for the individual as well as their families and communities.

“We are the sum of our experiences,” he said, explaining that it is vital that detention facilities provide comprehensive services and training programs for all prisoners — especially young people — throughout their time behind bars.

“If we’re sent to prison, there have to be comprehensive programs established for people,” he said. “They can’t just be sentenced to time served, but to achieve something.”

Those achievements prepare people for release and re-entry to society, he said. Positive development

for people growing up in “survival mode” is often based on positive interventions and opportunities for growth, he said.

“Prison is not a school — violence happens there,” he said. “But people shouldn’t necessarily fail if they get into a fight. The system needs to be understand the behaviors in relation to the environment.”

“A lot of young guys don’t have relationships, don’t have friendships,” he continued. “The socialization we have comes from the prison environment.”

Ultimately, he said, preparing people for re-entry is “paramount” and needs to begin on Day One of incarceration. Early interventions can foster constructive relationships and provide guidance, he said.

“The system has to find a way to build on these experiences,” he said.

paperwork.”

Applicants who are eligible for a full or partial waiver from the \$725 filing fee required by the USCIS will receive assistance at the event, according to the CUNY event page.

Citizenship applicants must be 18 years of age or older. They must have lived in the United States as a green card holder (permanent resident) for five years, or for three years if married to and living with the same U.S. citizen.

Eligible applicants must be at least 18 years old and have resided in the U.S. as permanent residents for at least five years, or three years if married and living with a U.S. citizen.

“The CUNY Citizenship Now campaign is providing an invaluable service to immigrants who dream of becoming official American citizens,” said Addabbo. “I hope those who are interested in applying will take advantage of this important opportunity.

The investigation is ongoing by the NYPD’s Highway Patrol Collision Investigation Squad.


In June, a bystander who witnessed 17-year-old Madeline Sershen die by an elderly motorist, started a change.org petition to reform the rules of the state’s Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) for older drivers.

a red light in Whitestone. In September, the driver Sheila Kahn-Prager avoided jail time after pleading guilty and surrendering her driver’s license.

The petition urges the DMV to require all drivers over the age of 80 to take a driving test every two years. As of Nov. 29, almost 24,000 people signed the petition, including Kahn-Prager.

Sershen’s family proposed making the re-testing requirement a law.





The Mystery Writers of America withdrew a major honor Thursday from author Linda Fairstein after other writers condemned the ex-prosecutor's role in New York's notorious "Central Park Five" case.

The decision, just two days after the Grand Master Award was announced, marked the first time the group has ever rescinded the prize, which recognizes lifetime achievement and has been given to such scribes as Sue Grafton and Stephen King.

"MWA cannot move forward with an award that lacks the support of such a large percentage of our members," the group said in a statement that also pledged to re-evaluate its process for selecting honorees.

Fairstein, known for her best-selling Alex Cooper novels, was speaking at a conference Thursday and referred an inquiry to her publisher, Penguin Publishing Group's Dutton imprint. It had no immediate comment.

When the award was announced Tuesday, Fairstein called it "a thrilling surprise."

"I'm pinching myself," she tweeted at the time.

But some prominent mystery writers, including Attica

Locke and Nick Kolakowski, expressed outrage over the decision. On Thursday, Locke tweeted "Thank you @EdgarAwards for listening."

Fairstein was the top Manhattan sex crimes prosecutor when five teenagers were charged with the 1989 rape and beating of a female investment banker jogging in Central Park.

The attack became a national symbol of urban mayhem at a time when New York City's murder rate was nearing its historical peak. The case also bared the city's racial and class divide, painting a portrait of a crew of black and Hispanic youths "wilding" and preying on a white professional. Donald Trump, a New York real estate developer at the time, bought full-page newspaper ads reading "Bring Back The Death Penalty. Bring Back Our Police!"

The teens said they were coerced into confessing their involvement in the attack. Their convictions were overturned in 2002 after convicted murderer and serial rapist Matias Reyes confessed to committing the crime alone, and DNA linked him to it.

Prosecutors stopped short of declaring the five innocent but withdrew all charges. The legal time clock had run out for charging Reyes, who was al-

ready serving life in prison on other convictions.

Fairstein observed the boys' 1989 interrogation, conducted by another prosecutor and police. She didn't personally try the case.

Since its collapse, she has denied the teens were coerced and has defended authorities' conduct in the case, explored in a 2013 documentary by Ken Burns.

The city reached a roughly \$41 million settlement with the five the next year, while not admitting any wrongdoing.

Locke and Fairstein exchanged caustic tweets after the award was announced. Locke, who is working with Ava DuVernay on a Netflix docudrama about the case, called Fairstein "almost singlehandedly responsible for the wrongful incarceration of the Central Park Five" and castigated her for not apologizing.

Fairstein responded by tweeting Locke should "learn your facts," adding: "Your anger and comments are so misdirected."

Fairstein garnered a reputation as a pioneering prosecutor of sexual offenses during her 25 years of leading the Manhattan district attorney's sex crimes unit. She retired in 2002 and began a successful career as a crime novelist, often drawing upon her past as a prosecutor.

Brooklyn Public Library Announces Finalists in Competition to Name Library's Historic Eagle Statue

Brooklyn Public Library announced the finalists in the competition to name the copper statue adorning the Grand Lobby of the Central Library. Local residents have until Dec. 14 to submit their vote.

Nearly 300 names were submitted this fall from around the borough and as far away as Los Angeles and Montreal. The finalists were selected by a team of BPL librarians, members of the Brooklyn Eagle and experts from the Brooklyn Historical Society. BHS formally gifted the sculpture to the library this summer.

The finalists include: **Wings of Wonder** ("Inspired by the inscription on the exterior of the Central Branch: 'Here are enshrined the longing of great hearts and noble things that tower above the tide, the magic word that winged wonder starts, the garnered wisdom that never dies.'")

Harmon ("Harmon is different voices coming together to make a new voice that reflects everyone which is something Brooklyn our country must stand for.")

Emily ("In honor of Emily Roebling, engineer of the Brooklyn Bridge.")

The eagle originally nested atop the Washington Street headquarters of the Brooklyn Daily Eagle newspaper. The library holds the historical records of the newspaper in the Brooklyn Collection, a vast public archive for

the study of Brooklyn's social and cultural history in the 19th and 20th centuries.

Following the demolition of the Brooklyn Daily Eagle building, the eagle sculpture was donated to Brooklyn Historical Society. From 1966 to 1987, the eagle sculpture was loaned to the Brooklyn Museum, where it stood in the museum's Warburg Sculpture Garden. After decades of battling the elements, the eagle sculpture returned to Brooklyn Historical Society in 1989 and underwent much needed conservation. The talons and the lower beak were recast in fiberglass and repainted to match the surrounding material. In 1997, upon completion of the restoration project, the sculpture was then loaned to the Brooklyn Public Library.

Rock the Bells concert and erroneously filed documents in California to obtain ownership of the song.

Problem is, Smith has no affiliation with Guerilla Union, Inc. — which was suspended for unpaid corporate taxes — according to a civil lawsuit filed in the United States District Court District of California Western Division on Tuesday.

Smith, 50, is seeking an unspecified amount for trademark infringement; false designation of origin, affiliation or association; cyberpiracy and unfair competition.

In 1998, Smith formed Rock the Bells Entertainment, Inc. in New York and trademarked several versions of “Rock the Bells.”

Nonetheless, the annual Rock the Bells concerts and tours were promoted, websites were created, social media handles were obtained and merchandise was sold

by Guerilla Union without Smith’s consent. Over the years, several hip hop legends like Common, Biz Markie and

Nas have performed.

Before Smith filed the lawsuit, his legal team Jill M. Pietrini and Paul A. Bost

of the Sheppard, Mullin, Richter & Hampton LLP filed a complaint with the U.S. Trademark Trial and Appeal

Board.

The exhibits filed with the court include 43 documents that break down Smith’s career since 1985 including the fact that “Rock the Bells” has been featured in various video game soundtracks and was named one of the “The 50 Greatest Hip-Hop Songs of All Time” by *Rolling Stone* magazine.

In February, a default judgement was ordered in Smith’s favor to cancel the trademark of The Guerilla Union Inc.’s use of the song title. The Guerilla Union Inc. did not appeal the decision.

With The Guerilla Union Inc. out of the way, Smith launched an exclusive radio channel on Sirius/XM in March called Rock The Bells Radio dedicated to classic hip hop music.

Smith’s lawyers sent a letter in June and July to request Weisberg turn over all social media handles and website domains linked to “Rock the Bells,” but Weisberg did not comply with

the demand.

“Without Mr. Smith’s consent, GUI continues to use the ROCK THE BELLS name and trademark on the Social Media Websites, or has allowed those Websites to be abandoned but still present online,” Pietrini wrote in the letter. “As a result, Mr. Smith is unable to obtain the social media handles directly related to his trademark ROCK THE BELLS and song of the same name. GUI’s continued use of ROCK THE BELLS on the Social Media Websites or allowing them to continue to be present constitutes trademark infringement, unfair competition, passing off, and false designation of origin and/or association.”

Requests by the *Eagle* for comment from Chang Weisberg, the president and founder of Guerilla Union Inc. through phone and email were unsuccessful.

United States District Court Central District of California Judge Christina A. Snyder is assigned to the case.

Firebug Heading To Prison For Torching Cars in South Ozone Park

A Queens man is expected to get sentenced to up to eight years in prison for setting nine cars on fire throughout his own neighborhood.

Evan Person admitted to Queens Supreme Court Justice John Zoll on Tuesday that on three separate occasions between December 2017 and February, he torched cars in around 116th Avenue, 124th Street and 109th Avenue in South Ozone Park.

“In pleading guilty, the defendant has now admitted to committing these reckless acts of arson,” said Queens District Attorney Richard A. Brown. “He damaged these

vehicles and knowingly endangered the lives of his fellow neighbors and firefighters, who responded to the scene of these fires.”

Person, 29, is expected to get sentenced to four to eight years in prison on Dec. 13 for the third-degree arson charge.

On Dec. 15, 2017, Person torched a 2006 Nissan, a 1998 Mercedes Benz, a 2000 Ford Excursion, a 2009 Nissan and a 2014 Mercedes Benz in various areas of 116th Avenue.

On Feb. 6, Person admitted to setting a 1998 Honda Civic, a 2003 Mitsubishi, and a 2008 Kia ablaze around 124th Street and on Feb. 16 setting a 2004 Buick on fire in front of a home on 109th Avenue.

New Concourse Opens at LaGuardia Airport

A new concourse with 18 gates is opening this weekend at LaGuardia Airport, part of a broader plan to modernize the dilapidated and oft-mocked facility.

The new gates are part of LaGuardia’s Terminal B and will open to passengers Saturday. The concourse also includes additional dining and shopping for those traveling through the airport.

All told, the \$8 billion plan to modernize LaGuardia includes 72 gates in six concourses and two new arrival and departure halls, for a total of 2.7 million square feet.

Other planned improvements include rail service between LaGuardia and midtown Manhattan and 14 miles of new road connecting motorists to the facility.

Gov. Andrew Cuomo joined local officials in Queens on Thursday for a ceremonial opening. The Democrat said the ongoing work will transform an aging, crowded and inefficient airport into a 21st-century facility “worthy of the state of New York.”

“This was an embarrassment,” Cuomo said of LaGuardia, adding that the work on the airport is proof that governments can still take on big, transformative infrastructure projects. “New York once again shows the way forward for this nation. If we can do it here, and set the example, you will see the nation follow.”

LaGuardia now handles about 30 million passengers each year. Of the 18 gates at the new concourse, 11 will be open this weekend. Service at the other seven will begin in 2020.

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ICE Came After Me And I Fought Back

When I opened the door on a cold, late December afternoon, right before heading out with my daughter, I remember sharing confused looks with her, wondering who was at our door. We don't receive visitors often. Most people don't know where we live, and as a matter of fact, I don't even have bills on my name since I'm an undocumented immigrant mother in the United States for more than 20 years now.

I opened the door to discover a mail person handing me a letter with my name. It was certified mail so I had to sign to confirm the receipt of it. I took the envelope, saw the logo — for the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement — and knew immediately what it was. A letter from ICE meant they were beginning deportation proceedings against me. I remember chuckling and thinking: Is this how they come to my house? Via certified mail?

I didn't realize I handed the letter to my daughter while I signed the receipt. When the mail person left, I closed the door, turned to my daughter and saw her with the letter in her hand. She was reading it, and tears were coming down her face. The envelope was ripped in many pieces. She was crying. All I could do was hug her and say, "Don't worry. Everything will be OK. They won't separate us."

Then, I could feel this rage taking over my body. How dare anyone make my daughter cry. How can anyone try to tear my family apart? As a single mother I always have fought to keep my daughter by my side, and to ensure her safety. Being a woman makes it twice as difficult.

That rage was the same rage I have felt for decades, since the first time I heard from other immigrants like me, telling me horrifying stories of families being separated by "la migra" — people taken, handcuffed and deported because they work without a piece of paper that would allow them to be in the country "legally." I have developed this rage during decades of fighting against family separations, lobbying for immigration reform and learning how we immigrants are used in the political game as scapegoats.

It is the same rage I feel every day I receive a call from someone detained at the Northwest Detention Center (NWDC) in Tacoma, Wash., one of the largest for-profit detention centers on the West Coast. Detainees tell me they are not able to talk to their loved ones because the calls are too expensive. They say there are people at the facility with mental illnesses or people that require surgery, and no one will provide the

medical services and urgent care necessary for their cases. They state many times they are going on a hunger strike so someone finally will listen.

That cold December afternoon, the rage was about my daughter and me. This time, ICE, la migra, was coming after me.

I called my *compañeras de lucha* (fighting companions), and a good friend of mine, a lawyer. The first question they asked was: How did they have your home address?

The important point here is ICE already knew of my existence. They have known about me since at least February 2014, when I did a civil disobedience action at NWDC to stop deportation buses, calling for an end to all detention and deportations. I and others joined the call with undocumented immigrants across America: #Not1More deportation.

We joined the direct action against ICE by staging our own shutdown in Tacoma. There, I came out as an undocumented mother, willing to be arrested, so people in our state would know about the existence of the detention center.

This action also was meant to show that we, undocumented people, were not afraid and that we would fight and lead our own struggle for liberation.

When we shut down one of the streets that rainy, cold February morning, one of the vans attempting to leave with people detained (shackled to the waist, hands and feet) had to stop right in front of us. We were on the ground, five of us, sitting on the wet pavement, linked by PVC pipes in our arms. I became nervous and afraid of the arrests. But when the van stopped in front of us, I could see the driver's angry eyes. Immediately behind him, I saw hands, hands moving, and I realized those were the hands of people detained and shackled. I immediately told my *compañeros*: "Shout! No están solos! Shout with me!"

And we shouted nonstop, chanting "no están solos!" We kept repeating this Spanish phrase, which means "you are not alone," until the van began to move backward and went back to the detention center.

At this moment, I stopped being afraid. I realized that was the reason why we had to risk arrest, so the detainees knew they are not alone. We are with them, with all of them.

We didn't get arrested, but what came next was much more powerful than the shutdown action we did. People detained that witnessed our action, two weeks later, began the largest hunger strike in a detention center in the U.S. Over 1,200 people refused meals to call attention to the inhumane conditions they face every day in the name of the immigration system and profits.

Since that day, March 7, 2014, the same group that helped put together the

shutdown action remained together so we all could support the hunger strike. I became the spokesperson for our group and for people detained. Two lawyers and I crashed a "community meeting" ICE organized that same month to address the hunger strike in NWDC. We were not invited, but another organization gave us their space in the meeting. We went to the same building in downtown Seattle to meet with ICE officials, where I now go to my court hearings for my own deportation case.

Later that same year, in May 2014, I had the opportunity to travel to Washington, D.C., and we requested a meeting with top officials at the Department of Homeland Security. I organized a delegation of four people to attend this meeting, with support from the office of Rep. Adam Smith, the congressman representing the district where NWDC is located. After some back and forth, I was allowed to go into the building, even though I don't have a Social Security number.

The first strike we supported lasted 56 days. After that, there were two more that year, in August and in October, and we continued supporting people in detention and in hunger strikes. There have been over a dozen hunger strikes at NWDC, and they have extended to other places, such as Texas and Oregon.

Since 2014, we have not stopped. Guided by people in detention, we expose the inhumane conditions and fight alongside them to ensure their leadership and organizing is protected from the outside. But we don't assume to be the leaders. We have shown the power of our collective by respecting people detained, not falling into the trap of division created by the system that tries to create levels of worthiness. We fight for all.

Our work has been successful. Mainstream media now cover these news stories. They also call us and recognize our expertise. Legal cases have been filed. The Washington attorney general filed a lawsuit against The Geo Group for their "voluntary \$1 per day work," the ACLU filed against Geo and ICE in the case of Jesus Chavez being beaten up by a Geo guard for joining a hunger strike, and the city of Tacoma passed an ordinance prohibiting Geo from expanding their current building capacity. Hundreds of people attend our actions every month. After this new U.S. regime announced a war against immigrants, first during the launch of a presidential campaign in 2015, and then immediately upon taking office with the issuing of executive orders in January 2018, we knew organizers could be next.

During 2017, we saw cases of organizers being detained after attending actions of

Migrant Justice. People spoke to the media about their loved ones being detained in Pacific County in Washington. Even those that attended the J20 protests in Washington, D.C., were targeted.

I didn't expect a letter to be sent to my house telling me I was next. But when I received one, I knew this wouldn't be the first time we fight back. As we have done for many others, we began mobilizing and creating a defense committee and announced publicly we would not be intimidated. Hundreds of people showed up to the ICE building in downtown Seattle on Jan. 16, 2018, despite extreme cold weather. Hundreds of supporters began to write, text, call, email, lending us support of all kinds—legal, monetary, spiritual, even offering to feed my daughter and me, if necessary.

It was such an overwhelming experience. My daughter and I cried, but this time, our tears were due to the love shown by our community. Even people detained began calling me just to find out if I was OK, saying, "You are not alone." Now, my tears are full of love coming from inside those walls. Now I understand how they felt when I was outside chanting for them. Now they are chanting for me, even if they are still inside detained.

All of this support has given us the resources and energy required to fight back. We received the support of one of our federal senators, Maria Cantwell. Her office was able to obtain a document ICE denied my lawyer, I-213, the form ICE sends to the immigration judge explaining why I should appear before him to begin my deportation proceedings.

This document shows what we knew: I was being targeted because I organize against ICE and in support of my immigrant, Latinx community. We also learned that the Washington State Department of Licensing gave my personal information to ICE, which is how they obtained my home address.

We have attended every hearing in my case alongside hundreds of people. Every time I go in that courtroom, I know I'm not alone. Every time I go into the courtroom, I count how many families besides mine are there. And I

always wonder how different the outcome of each of their cases would be if hundreds of supporters would show up for them as well. Every time I see the eyes of other mothers like me fighting to keep their families together, and when I receive calls from the detention center (mainly from men, since that is the biggest population incarcerated there), I can hear the desperation in their voices. But I also hear the hope. They know we answer the phone, and most importantly, we are willing to fight alongside them. I know ICE is targeting me because I made the decision to protect my family and my community, but I don't regret doing so. I made a commitment because I can't wait for someone else to do it for me. I believe we are the leaders of our own liberation.

Activism is not a choice. It's a need, and not all activism looks the same. Everyone must contribute in some way or another. We have people released from the detention center taking leadership in our group. We have white people helping us with logistics during actions. We collaborate

with other groups fighting prisons. We open the spaces at every action recognizing the stolen land we stand on and the different first nations of the land.

Whatever people end up doing to support our work, we invite them to be familiar with our work at the local and national level, and to show up in support of those detained and those in deportation proceedings.

We are not going anywhere without a fight. As a mother, I will continue fighting to stay with my daughter, and I will continue supporting my community. I won't be intimidated. I won't allow fear to take over my life. I will continue working until ICE is abolished and NWDC is shut down. I won't stop.

Trump's Private Plane Clipped in Parking Mishap at LaGuardia

President Donald Trump's private jet, an instantly recognizable Boeing 757 used during his campaign, was caught up in a quintessential New York City traffic mishap at LaGuardia Airport on Wednesday: a fender bender while someone else was trying to park.

A corporate jet maneuvering into a parking spot clipped the wing of Trump's parked plane around 8:30 a.m., Trump's company, The Trump Organization, confirmed. The plane was parked and not in use, it said.

The corporate jet, a twin-engine Bombardier Global Express, had three crew members aboard. It had just completed an 18-minute flight from Islip, on Long Island, and was being guided by ground personnel along a ramp near the general aviation terminal.

No one was on Trump's plane.

Trump used the jet throughout his 2016 run for the White House but hasn't done so since taking office, opting for Air Force One instead.

The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey, which operates LaGuardia, said there were no injuries and no impact on airport operations.

The extent of damage to the planes wasn't immediately clear. According to the aviation tracking website FlightAware, the corporate jet flew Wednesday afternoon to Hartford, Connecticut, where

Bombardier has a service center. Trump's plane is blocked from being tracked on the site.

Trump bought his jet, a retrofitted commercial airliner, from the late Microsoft co-founder Paul Allen in 2011 for \$100 million. It was previously used by a low-budget Mexican passenger carrier.

Trump flexed the jet as a symbol of wealth, power and convenience during his presidential campaign, using it to commute almost every night to New York, home to his Manhattan penthouse apartment.

The plane — painted black and red, with the Trump name in big, gold letters — features a bedroom, 24-karat gold-plated fixtures and leather seats, according to a Trump Organization video. During the campaign, it became known as Trump Force One and was a familiar backdrop for Trump's airport hangar rallies.

Lately, the plane has turned into something of a LaGuardia landmark, with fliers snapping photos from passing jets and posting them on social media.

Wednesday's incident wasn't the first involving a Trump campaign plane at LaGuardia.

A Boeing 737 charter plane carrying then-vice presidential candidate Mike Pence overran a runway while landing in the rain on Oct. 27, 2016, about two weeks before the election. No one was hurt.

Colombian Drug Kingpin Testifies Against 'El Chapo'

A former Colombian drug lord known for his plastic surgeries is testifying at the trial of "El Chapo" in Brooklyn's federal court for the Eastern District of New York.

Juan Carlos Ramirez Abadia told the jury Thursday that he used drug lord Joaquin Guzman's Mexican cartel to help smuggle tons of Colombian cocaine into large U.S. cities.

Ramirez Abadia said he tried to hide his identity by

surgically altering his eyes, cheeks, jaw and nearly every other facial feature.

He was arrested in Brazil in 2007 and sent to the United States, where he pleaded guilty to drug and murder charges and became a cooperator.


Abadia estimated that he ordered at least 150 killings while leading the Norte de Valle cartel.

Guzman has pleaded not guilty to drug-trafficking charges. He asserts that he is being framed by shady cooperators.

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NY Court of Appeals Rules In Favor of Jury Trials for B Misdemeanors in NYC Collateral Immigration Consequences Matter

On Nov 27, 2018, the New York State Court of Appeals ruled in the case of *People v. Suazo* (2018 NY Slip Op 08056), in which it declared that collateral immigration consequences — such as deportation — constitute a serious enough punishment to justify a jury trial for a B-Misdemeanor crime in New York City.

“The Sixth Amendment of the United States Constitution guarantees that a defendant will be judged by a jury of peers if charged with a serious crime. Today, as a matter of first impression, we hold that a noncitizen defendant who demonstrates that a charged crime carries the potential penalty of deportation — i.e.

removal from the country — is entitled to a jury trial under the Sixth Amendment.” — *People v. Suazo*.

The current law in New York State, Criminal Procedure Law §340.40(2), states that defendants charged with crimes constituting a B-Misdemeanor (only punishable up to 90 days of imprisonment) within the City of New York are not entitled to jury trials. However, defendants in counties outside of the City of New York such as Long Island or upstate are entitled to jury trials.

District Attorneys will often move to reduce their weakest A-Misdemeanor cases into B-Misdemeanor attempt charges in order to deny a defendant the opportunity to have his or her

case heard by a jury. This is a sneaky and underhanded move as convictions are more likely in a judicial bench trial than a jury trial. Very weak Assault in the 3rd Degree cases will be reduced to Attempted Assault in the 3rd Degree or Attempted Criminal Obstruction of Breathing.

The decision in *Suazo* does not limit the right of a trial by jury in B-Misdemeanors to those facing immigration consequences. The court stated:

“A defendant is entitled to a jury trial...only if [the defendant] can demonstrate that any additional statutory penalties, viewed in conjunction with the maximum authorized period of incarceration, are so severe that they clearly reflect a

legislative determination that the offense in question is a ‘serious’ one.” — *People v. Suazo*.

Therefore, defendants in New York City facing a B-Misdemeanor charge have the burden to demonstrate that the consequences they face are so serious they justify a jury trial. This leaves opportunity for tremendous amounts of litigation to test the boundaries of the *Suazo* decision.

Some alternative scenarios may present a similarly compelling exception, for example would a full order of

protection lasting two years between two individuals, especially a parent and child, thereby effectively terminating that relationship, constitute a serious enough punishment to justify a jury trial? Does a consequence of a conviction to a professional license constitute a serious enough punishment to justify a jury trial?

The courts will be dealing with such issues brought on by experienced New York criminal defense attorneys like myself. The *Suazo* decision raises other questions.

For example, does it make sense to allow non-citizens to have a right to jury trial in circumstances where a citizen of the United States would not? Does the geographic discrimination of CPL 340.40(2) make sense?

The Law Office of Ali Najmi believes compelling arguments under the equal protection clause of the 14th Amendment or Article 1, §11 of the State Constitution in light of the *Suazo* decision are strong legal arguments to be tested in litigation.

Pomonok Houses Tenants Take Lead on Lead Testing

Tens of thousands of tenants across Queens’ 21 NYCHA developments are contending with the threat of toxic lead inside their homes. Overall, the developments contain 15,716 apartments — and an unknown number of those units contain lead paint.

At the Pomonok Houses, at least, tenants are taking matters into their own hands and testing for lead, thus performing a duty their

landlord — New York City — should have taken care of decades ago.

The Pomonok Residents Association has partnered with Assemblymember Daniel Rosenthal, U.S. Rep. Grace Meng, State Sen. Toby Stavisky and Councilmember Rory Lancman to sponsor free lead testing in the development.

“Given NYCHA’s current lead paint scandal, we as residents, parents and concerned community

leaders see the importance in having this screening in our community,” said Pomonok Residents Association President Tamika Williams. “Now that we know the fact, it’s time to get tested.”

A handful of children a the Pomonok Houses have already tested positive for elevated lead levels. They are just a few of the more than 1,000 children living in NYCHA apartments who have tested positive for toxic lead levels since 2010.

“It is a shame that our families have become victims to improper management and care by the city,” Rosenthal said. “By offering free lead testing, we take the first steps towards ensuring that our children receive the medical attention they need.”

The tests are performed by Kamin Health, a Queens-based company. The initiative will continue at Union Medical Urgent Care, located at 186-06 Union Turnpike in Fresh Meadows through January 2019.

“We stand ready and willing to help in any way we can,” said Kamin Health Managing Director Yaakov Landau.

A map created by the *Daily News* in December 2017 plotted lead paint in at least 183 units in Queens

NYCHA developments, but children in many more of the borough’s NYCHA units are likely at risk, said Ellie Hecht, the Director of At-Risk Community Services. Hecht’s organization advocates for the rights of public housing residents and worked closely with the Citywide Council of Presidents, a tenants’ rights group comprised of tenant representatives from various NYCHA developments.

“[NYCHA] has been systematically lying about lead paint and lead paint levels for years and I don’t know if there’s any data that can be trusted at this point,” Hecht told the *Eagle* in July. “NYCHA has been on record for not doing site inspections for lead for years ... It’s almost impossible to unravel.”
